This workshop will be conducted over 5 **interactive sessions** to be held once per week. Dr. Amr Abdalla, Karamah's Senior Advisor on Conflict Resolution, will conduct the workshop with Ms. Nabila Boukri. The course will provide participants with key concepts and skills for conflict resolution in family, effective community and workplace settings. It will include perspectives derived from Quran and Sunnah using conflict resolution research lens in order to emphasize the Islamic guidance of peaceful behavior in times of conflict. The workshop uses interactive and participatory pedagogies and provides safe space for participants' sharing and growth.

- By Thursday after each weekend session, participants will share with everyone the reflection notes about lessons learned based on the learnings of the week The reflection notes can be in written format (English, Arabic or French) or in a recorded video.

Those who will have to miss no more than one session, will be expected to complete a make-up assignment in order to receive the certificate.

From 2014 to 2017

Dr. Amr Abdalla was the Senior Advisor on Policy Analysis and Research at the Institute for Peace and Security Studies (IPSS) of Addis Ababa University.tions are communication tools. In 2013-2014, he was Vice President of SALAM Institute for Peace and Justice in Washington, D.C.

More recently, in 2018 he led the publication of the first Arabic Glossary of Terms in Peace and Conflict Studies in cooperation with UNDP-Iraq and the Iraqi Amal Association.

From 2001-2013

He was Professor, Dean and Vice Rector at UPEACE. Prior to that, he was a Senior Fellow with the Peace Operations Policy Program, School of Public Policy, at George Mason University, Virginia. In 2011, he established with Egyptian UPEACE graduates a program for community prevention of sectarian violence in Egypt (Ahl el Hetta).

From 1981-1986, he was a member of the public prosecutor team investigating the case of the assassination of President Sadat and numerous other terrorism cases. He then emigrated to the U.S. where he obtained a Master's degree in Sociology and a Ph.D. in Conflict Analysis and Resolution from George Mason University. He has been an active figure in promoting interfaith dialogue and effective cross-cultural messages through workshops and community presentations in the United States and beyond. He pioneered the development of the first conflict resolution teaching and training manual for Muslim communities titled ("...Say Peace").

The third framework: "Ethical Intervention Approaches", provides an overview of three distinct approaches, each with its own unique values, norms, goals and processes.

"Islamic Perspectives on Integrative Conflict Behavior"

The fourth framework offers a socialsciences, non-legalistic approach, supported by the first two frameworks, to extrapolate foundational and essential elements of how Islamic sources, mainly the Quran and Sunnah, guide behavior in conflict towards de-escalation and peaceful interventions.

Framework 5 and 6

The fifth framework: "Islamic Wheels of Conflicts", distinguishes between four types of issues that members of Muslim communities confront. The distinction among the four types is based on the nature of issues and the extent of their regulation according to Islamic sources. The four types are: Value Parameters, Juristic Matters, Cultural Issues, and Needs and Interests.

The sixth framework: "Islamic Conflict Intervention Techniques", offers a repertoire of interventions, including innovative approaches to applying fiqh and pursuing legal interpretations, utilizing a positive role of community members, and empowering individuals through models of negotiation, mediation, and pursuit of professional help.
